

# CHS BPO Bake Sale Guidelines

Below are guidelines for preparing baked items for Central High School Band Parent Organization's bake sales. These guidelines are meant to help keep the various baked goods "equal" in our buyer's eyes and to provide top notch quality goodies.

1. Place baked goods in zip-lock bags or wrap them in some fashion. Be creative and colorful if you'd like.
2. Label items that contain nuts.
3. Items that sell the best are listed below, but feel free to bring whatever you would like.
  - a. Puppy Chow
  - b. Rice Krispy Bars
  - c. Scotcharoo Bars (peanut butter Rice Krispy bars topped with chocolate)
  - d. Brownies
  - e. Trail Mixes
  - f. Dipped or coated pretzels (little pretzels or pretzel rods)
  - g. Cookies (large & soft)
4. Everything is \$1 so please create generous portions:
  - a. Puppy Chow / Trail Mixes - a heaping cup to a cup and a fourth
  - b. Bars / Brownies - two 3" bars
  - c. Cookies - two 3" diameter or three 2" diameter or one giant sized cookie
5. We haven't had much luck with cupcakes as they are somewhat messy. If you have a creative way to package them so that the icing isn't smashed all over the "wrapping"; give it a try!
6. Use a plastic knife to cut brownies as it makes a much smoother edge.
7. Please ensure your ingredients are fresh.

You may have your student bring wrapped/bagged baked goods in the morning to school on the day of the event and place in the Bake Sale collection bin in the Band Room. Or they may drop them off when they arrive for call time that evening.

Please remind your student to be gentle with the baked goods or box them up so they don't get smashed. You may also bring items to the bake sale table when you come to the game.

Band students, band directors and assistants may receive a free treat from the bake sale table at the beginning of the third quarter of the game - if we have enough treats for all of them.

**Please bake so we don't have disappointed faces!!**

Remember to sign up to help out at the bake sale table. We need people to set up, to sell during the game and to clean up afterwards.
