BLACK HISTORY FACT:

One in four cowboys was Black, despite the stories told in popular books and movies.

In fact, it's believed that the real "Lone Ranger" was inspired by an African American man named Bass Reeves. Reeves had been born a slave but escaped West during the Civil War where he lived in what was then known as Indian Territory. He eventually became a Deputy U.S. Marshal, was a master of disguise, an expert marksman, had a Native American companion, and rode a silver horse.

SPRING SPORTS ELIGIBILITY: Students that plan to try-out for a spring sport (baseball, soccer, track, boys golf, girls tennis), must get an eligibility card in Office 139 in order to participate on the first day of practice March 1, 2021. Athletes that were out for a winter sport must get a new eligibility card for the spring season. If you do not have a physical dated after May 1, 2020 you will need to get a new physical before you can try-out. You must have all parts of the six-page OPS Physical Form filled out as well.
